CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entrants must produce a current BJC licence on the day.
2. Entrants licence must include a photograph, and date of birth.
3. Competitors entering the Espoir group, must have reached the age of 16, but not be 18 years on the day. Proof of age will be necessary.
4. Closing date for all entries will be last post on Tuesday 26th June 2007.

Entries will not be accepted after the closing date.

5. Weigh-in will be strictly controlled, with "one" weigh only (removal of jacket only is permitted). The Weigh-in Saturday 7-8 pm all groups and Sunday 9 am (initial categories primaries, which will close at 9.45 am) at the Venue. This competition is scheduled to commence at 10.30 am.

6. We reserve the right to restrict any category to a maximum of 32 entrants.
7. Weight changes (upward only) on the day subject to item 6. (plus a penalty of £2).
8. Team managers only will be allowed to accompany entrants to weigh-in.
9. Team managers only allowed to confer with the Mat Marshall.
- 10 The BJC reserve the right to record by film or video, all or any part of the competition

NO VIDEO PASSES WILL BE ISSUED.

COMPETITION REGULATIONS

1. No coaching will be allowed during the competition.
2. Judogi must comply with BJC contest rules. Females must additionally wear a plain white T-shirt.
3. No refreshments, drinks etc, to be taken to the side of the mat.
Drinking water is available from the "table".
4. All competitors must comply with the regulations regarding footwear, ie Zorri's only, to be worn to the side of the mat. " Trainers" everyday shoes etc are not permitted.
5. Where there are sufficient numbers, categories will be fought in the preliminary round as pools, then a knockout with repercharge.
6. Gold, silver and 2 bronzes awards will be made in all categories fought.
- 7 The BJC reserves the right to amalgamate any weight category.
8. Arm-locks and strangles are not permitted in categories u25kg, u30kg, u35kg, & u40kg.
Photographs maybe taken at this event please make representation if you do not wish your child to be photographed.
9. The following techniques are forbidden in categories of 40kg & below. 1) All sacrifice techniques as direct techniques, combination techniques & counter techniques, with exception of Tomoe-Nage & Yoko-Tome-Nage, which are still permitted. 2) Drop knee Seoi-Nage.
- 10. All Primary entrants having been awarded a junior grade are not permitted to participate in any of the Primary categories.**
