Due to the verbal abuse, intimidation and threatening behaviour towards Referees and Officials the additional conditions of entry are applicable in all future BJC Championships.

Entry to BJC Championships is conditional upon all entrants, their respective Coaches, Parents, Team Mangers and supporters etc agreeing to abide by the following requirements: -

- 1) No person at all is permitted to encroach upon the competition or Official's side of the Arena.
- 2) Referee's decisions and judgements are not subject to question and no approach to the Mat Marshall or any other Official is permitted.
- 3) No person at all is permitted to approach any Table Official's table and peruse any paperwork.
- 4) A request (by a Team Manager only) to speak to the Mat Marshall regarding a possible error in recording paperwork can be made to a Steward.
- 5) Excessive verbal encouragement is frowned upon and will be subject to reprimand.
- 6) Video passes are no longer available.
- 7) Club Officials have a responsibility for the behaviour of all their accompanying supporters and should ensure that supporters etc are au fait with the expected good manners and etiquette of the BJC and all the aforementioned conditions.

Persons not complying with the above conditions will be required to leave the Hall.

Extract from the President's foreword to the British Judo Council Contest Rules.

“Once a contestant has entered into a contest the decision of the Referee, right or wrong, fair or unfair, biased or not, that decision is absolutely final. These rules are not devised for contestants, or indeed any other person, to use in any way that is contrary to the spirit of Judo. They are merely a perimeter within which our members can contest freely with an attitude true to the BJC aims and objectives of promoting traditional judo values”.
