## CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES: 6<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER 2008

### THE JUBILEE KATA TOURNAMENT RULES OF COMPETITION

1. This is pairs competition. Each pair consists of one person acting as "tori" and another as "uke". Entry open to BJC & BJA licence holders.
2. The order of performance will be decided by the drawing of lots at the commencement of the category.
3. In the Senior competition, Each pair will be expected to perform the complete kata. The Junior competition has different rules (set out below).
4. There will be three judges per category, who will not confer on marking.
5. Each pair will be marked out of 100 according to the following criteria:

| (a) Technical merit (quality/accuracy of each technique) | 50% |
| (b) Commitment to the kata (commitment/energy)           | 20% |
| (c) Harmony between tori and uke                         | 20% |
| (d) Posture and style                                    | 10% |
6. No marks will be notified until the end of the category.
7. The final mark per pair will be reached by dividing the total number of points awarded by ALL the judges and dividing by the number of judges to give a final mark out of 100.
8. In the unlikely event of a tie, EACH judge on the panel of judges shall choose which pair should be considered the winner. The winning pair will be decided by a 'majority of three'. That result will be final.
9. Should any clashes of kata tournaments occur (e.g. due to overrunning), the organisers will ensure that pairs can compete in both events by making such alterations as are necessary to the running order.
10. Special rules for the junior tournament  
In order to encourage the study of kata at junior level, we are introducing a junior tournament. The junior tournament comprises the following categories:
  - A. JUNIOR NAGE "A" - Demonstration of the SECOND set of Nage No Kata;
  - B. JUNIOR NAGE "B" - Demonstration of the FIRST THREE sets of Nage No Kata
  - C. JUNIOR KATAME - Demonstration of the FIRST set of Katame No Kata;
11. A pair may enter either Nage "A" or Nage "B" but not both.
