1st kyu and above: Full kata.

### Katame no kata

Under 3rd kyu: First set

3rd kyu and 2nd kyu: First and second sets.

1st kyu and above: Full kata.

**PLEASE READ THESE RULES CAREFULLY BEFORE FILLING IN THE ENTRY FORM.**

- Entrants must produce a valid licence upon booking in at the start of the event, with all details filled in and an up-to-date photograph.
- Entry to the Tournament is £7.50 per person plus £5 per person for each additional Kata.
- Booking in will take place between 9.15am and 10am for primaries and juniors; and between 11am and midday for seniors.
- All entries must be received by the end of Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> October 2017. Late entries and additional Kata entries on the day will be accepted at the organiser's discretion only.
- We reserve the right to restrict or combine categories on the day.
- Tori and uke's grades need not be in the same category, but the group they compete in will be determined by the highest grade of the pair.
- Any ongoing medical issues or conditions which the judges should be aware of must be detailed on the entry form. E.g. "*Asthmatic, needs inhaler at side on mat*"
- No coaching will be allowed during the Tournament.
- Judogi must comply with BJC contest rules and zori must be worn to the mat-side. Females must wear a plain white high neck T-shirt.
- For safety the mat-side must be kept clear of all unnecessary items.
- Gold, silver and bronze medals will be available in all categories.
- Photographs and video may be taken by at this event. If you do not wish your child to be photographed, please highlight this on the entry form.
- **The object of this Tournament is to allow for entrants to demonstrate as much kata as they are able to. If time is available, each pair of entrants will be encouraged to demonstrate as many complete sets of their Kata as they can. However, they will only be marked upon the sets that are required for their group, as stated on the entry form.**
