## **FPJ Revalidation Procedure**

## With immediate effect:

If you hold FPJ level 1 BJC coaching qualification <u>only</u>, the revalidation will be required by attending a FPJ level 1 or Level 2 course within 3 years of the previous validity date.

If you hold both FPJ level 1 and 2 BJC coaching qualifications revalidation will be by attending a full FPJ level 2 course or a FPJ level 2 revalidation course, within 3 years of the previous validity date.

It is no longer required for coaches to alternate between level 1 and level 2, as common practice.

## Points of Clarification:

It is intended that candidates will revalidate during the 3rd year, before the expiry date of their most recent FPJ.

Therefore in these cases the new expiry date will be set 3 years from the expiry date of the previous award of that level.

If validity has already expired the new date expiry will be 3 years from the date of the revalidation course.
