The following are a list of the current BJC Kata requirements at Gradings.

**Please note -**

Examination for Kata is to be done on the day of the contest - in exceptional circumstances the grading officer may allow Kata to be deferred. In these cases the Grading officer will allocate a particular Kata examiner and a time scale for the Kata examination. Failure to meet these arrangements could result in the grading being considered unsuccessful.
